INSANE RIDE ENTRY PROCESS

It may be Hard Enduro but let's keep the entry process as easy as possible. Please find below some steps for those that may be new to Ridernet.

- Create an account at <u>www.ridernet.com.au</u> Similar to creating an email address
- Club Membership
 - O Click on your name Profile Clubs memberships Add club
 - o The club to add is "Swansea Motorcycle Association"
 - This has been discounted to \$20 given the time of the season
- Riding Number
 - o All riders will need a TAS HARD ENDURO riding number
 - o Click on Name Profile Riding numbers add riding number
 - State is Tas
 - o Discipline is Enduro
 - o Type is Hard Enduro 7-99
 - Select your riding number and save
 - If you are using a one event licence you will need to email <u>admin@mtas.org.au</u> with your preferred number.
- Riding licence
 - One event licence or annual licences available
 - o Iron class only requires recreational licence, remaining classes require annual competitive or one event competitive licence.
 - One event licences can be purchased during event setup Move onto event entry section.
 - Annual licence
 - Click on name Profile licences Add Riding licence competitive licence – senior national licence
 - Follow prompts
- Event entry and ONE EVENT licence
 - Click on Events at the top of the page
 - o Change "To date" to November 1 2025
 - Type "insane" in the find box and hit search Register
 - Follow prompts selecting class etc, you will be prompted by a red box to add a one event licence if you do not already hold a current riding licence.
 - Your riding number is the number you selected in the above steps.

Please note that discounted bike freight booked in singles is only available until the end of September along with the early bird discounted entry price.
